

50 YEARS OF POP ART Selections from the Frederick R. Weisman Art Foundation

August 28–December 2, 2018

Since Pop Art appeared in the early 1960s, artists have drawn inspiration from popular culture. Featuring vintage examples of historic Pop Art, combined with work by younger artists, this exhibition looks at the varied ways contemporary art continues to reflect mass media and daily life.

RICHARD DIEBENKORN: BEGINNINGS, 1942–1955 Crocker Art Museum, Sacramento & the Richard Diebenkorn Foundation.

January 12–March 31, 2019

This landmark exhibition is the first to look at the formative years of Richard Diebenkorn (1922–1993), one of California's most important modern artists. Focused on work rarely seen by the public, it explores how his style evolved from early figurative work, to mature Abstract Expressionism, and back again to the figure.

Each year Pepperdine's ARTSReach Program, supported by the Center for the Arts Guild, inspires the lives of thousands of schoolchildren from Ventura to the inner city of Los Angeles. These free arts experiences enrich the lives of children with world-class performances and art museum tours.
